

**NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF POSTAL SUPERVISORS  
MINUTES OF MEETING  
OCTOBER 14, 2021**

**LEGISLATIVE UPDATE**

- Ann advised that on Wednesday, October 13<sup>th</sup>, she participated in a Zoom meeting, hosted by Bob Levy and Chuck Mulidore, for all State Legislative Directors. They are advising all members to contact their Congressional Representative for support of HR3076. The bill needs to pass on the floor of the House. If passed other postal bills will follow.

Pat advised that she will contact Labor Relations concerning training for new supervisors to ensure they know their duties. Best advice is for everyone to do their job to the best of their ability and to document any irregularities.
